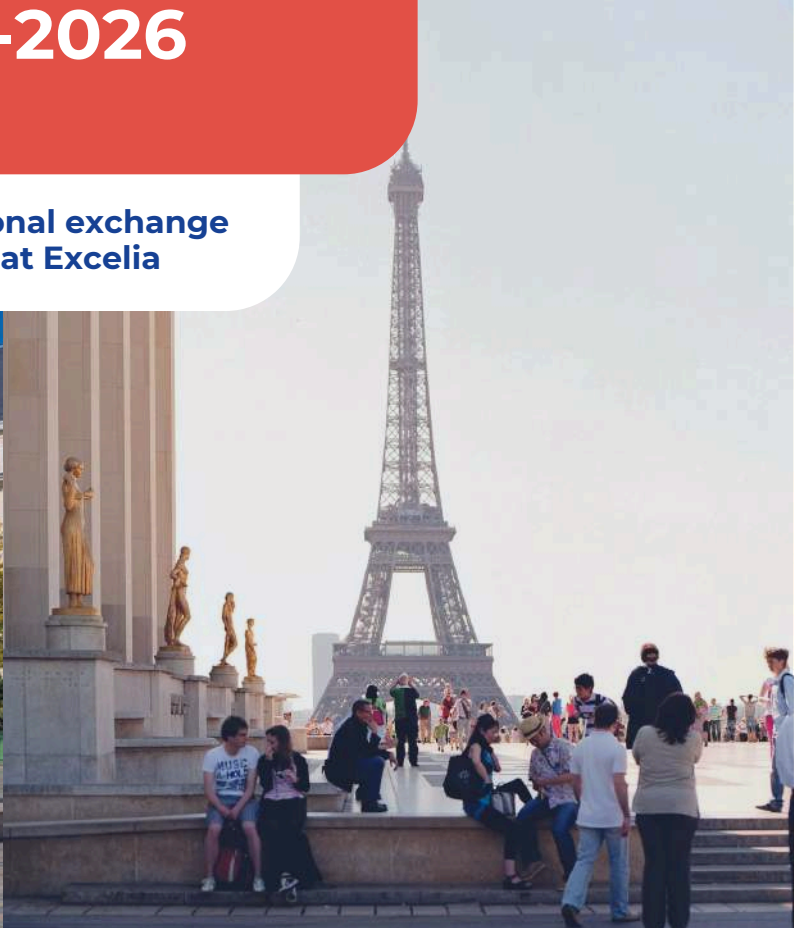

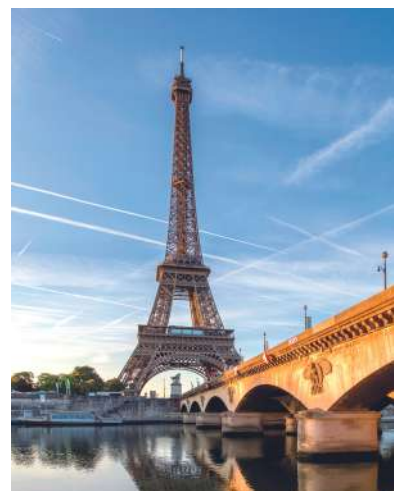

ARRIVAL DATE	Students are expected to arrive BEFORE their scheduled Welcome Days.
WELCOME DAYS	Students should refer to their acceptance letter for full details of the date and location of their Welcome Days event. This event is compulsory.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> ① The Coordinator/International Office of the Partner University nominates exchange students on the WEBGAIA platform: webgaia.excelia-group.com ② Excelia's International Office then validates these exchange students on the platform ③ Once validated, the students can create their personal account and complete their registration with the following required documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy of passport or ID • Curriculum Vitae (resume) • Most recent academic transcript of record (marks/grades) • Proof of Health Insurance for the duration of their stay

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The recommended minimum for exchange students is 20 ECTS credits per semester, with a maximum of 30 ECTS credits • If students enroll in a course, they are required to attend it and take the final exam • Students taking a double degree must validate 30 ECTS credits per semester • Language of teaching: French or English, depending on chosen programme • A minimum B2 level is mandatory (CEFR)
EXCELIA TRANSCRIPT OF RECORD (MARKS/GRADES)	<p>Excelia issues electronic transcripts, in PDF format. The digital signature on the transcript is the equivalent of a handwritten signature or official stamp. Digital documents are therefore considered official records.</p> <p>Exchange students can download their electronically signed transcripts from their WEBGAIA account.</p> <p>The electronic transcript of records is a valid format for all situations where signed and stamped paper documents are required. If a partner university refuses to accept this digitally signed document, students can request a signed and stamped paper document from Excelia by sending an email to: globalexchange@excelia-group.com.</p>

ACCOMMODATION

Excelia does not have its own student accommodation. Once an exchange student's application has been received and validated by our international office, they will receive access codes to our dedicated accommodation platform.

HEALTH INSURANCE

From their very first day in France, international students must have health insurance to cover medical expenses, hospitalization, surgery, and repatriation (in addition, they must also have civil liability insurance).

- **EU students:** you will need to provide a copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in order to complete your online registration
- **Non-EU students:** You will need to arrange health insurance before your arrival; however, if your stay in France is longer than 4 months, you are entitled to join the French social security system
